#### Science

They will be practicing the different skills before eventually drawing a self portrait in the style of "Frida Kahlo".

### P.E.

We will be teaching the children Dance and Games.

The Dance will focus on the theme of "We are what we eat" and the Games focus will be Multiskills.

## **English**

We shall be focusing on texts with a food theme. We will be working with the books-, Supertato-Run, Veggies, Run! and Pumpkin Soup.
