

### Science

The children will be learning about the human body. They will also be taught how to label and name their basic body parts. The Year 2 children will be taught the importance of exercise, hygiene and about eating the right amounts of different types of food.

### History

### P.E.

### English

### Maths

The children's Maths lessons will focus on: -

#### Yr1

- Place Value to 10
- Addition and Subtraction
- Shape and Patterns

#### Yr2

- Place value to 100
- Addition and Subtraction to 100
- Shape

### Computing

The children's learning will be based on the topics of **Paint** and **Computer Art**. They will learn how to use a Chromebook and an iPad to access different paint programmes. They will then use the different paint tools to create a self-portrait.

### RHE with JIGSAW

We will be following the topic “**Being me in my world**”.

The children will be exploring what makes them special and a good friend. They will also be learning about how to keep themselves safe and healthy.

### Music

We will be following the topics “**Hey you**” and “**Hands, Feet and Heart**”. The children will be learning how to use their voices expressively to sing songs, speak chants and rhymes.

### RE
