Science

Our focus this half term is

Materials. The children will be
learning about where materials come
from and how they are used. They
will be sorting materials based on
their different properties.
They will also be investigating
different materials that are suitable
for a house roof.

Geography

In our Geography lessons, we will be learning about human and physical features associated with our local area and in particular Clipstone woods. We will then be learning about the specific features of villages, towns and cities.

Design Technology

The children will be **designing** houses using different materials. They will then work in groups to **make** the houses.

We will be teaching them how to **evaluate** the houses they have made against their original design.

P.E.

We will be teaching **Indoor Dodgeball** and **Games** this half term.

In Indoor Dodgeball lessons, the children will be learning the skills needed to play a game and in Games we will be using the parachute to teach them skills about working in a team.

English

We shall be using the texts: -The True story of The Three Little Pigs and The Three Little Wolves and The Big Bad Pig.

Our shared reading texts will be around the theme of Bonfire Night, Diwali and alternative fairy tales.

All children will have Handwriting, Grammar and Spelling lessons throughout the week.

Maths

The children will be having Maths lessons every day focused on:-

Yr1-Place value to 20, Number facts to 20, Counting in 2s,5s and 10s and using money.

Yr2-Place value to 100, Number facts to 100,Quick number facts related to 2,5 and 10.

There will also be some reasoning and problem-solving lessons during the week

Computing

In computing this half term, we will be looking at **Online** safety and **How to use the** internet.

The children will be learning the SMART rules and about how to keep their passwords safe when going online.

RSHE/JIGSAW

We will be following the topic "Celebrating Difference".

The children will be exploring the idea that everyone is different and that this is good. We shall also be discussing what is different between "Bullying" and "Falling out".

Music

We will be following the topics "Rhythm in the way we walk/The Banana Rap" and "Ho,Ho,Ho".

This will focus on pulse, rhythm and pitch. The children will learn to sing different styles of music and discuss how it makes them feel.

RE

In our RE lessons, the Year 1 children will be learning about the **Christmas story.**

The Year 2 children will be learning about the different symbols used at Christmas including the **advent wreath**.
