

Science

Our focus this half term is **Living things and their habitats**. The children will be learning about different animals and where they live. They will be sorting animals into carnivores, herbivores, and omnivores. This will help them to make a simple food chain.

Geography

This half term we will be focusing on about Map Skills. The children will be looking at aerial photographs and maps of our school. They will then learn how to make their own map of our school playground including a simple key.

Art and Design

The children will be learning about the artist **Caroline Bell**, who uses natural materials to print with. They will be learning what the primary colours are and how to make secondary colours using them. They will be learning how to create shade and tint.

P.E.

We will be teaching **Games** and **Dance** this half term. The **Games** work will focus on invasion games and in particular rounders. The children will learn the skills needed for attacking and defending. The **Dance** focus will be around the story of "Where the wild things are". The children will create sequences of movements to put together to form a dance.

English

We shall be using the texts: -**The Bad Tempered Ladybird and The Bug Girl**. All children will have Handwriting, Grammar and Spelling lessons throughout the week. In shared reading, the teachers will be focusing on **Stories and Non-fiction texts about minibeasts and habitats**.

Where the wild things are



Maths

The children will be having Maths lessons every day focused on: -
Yr1- Numbers to 100, Addition and Subtraction and Money
Yr2- Fractions and Time
There will also be problem-solving lessons which will focus on the concepts which have been taught during that week.

Computing

In computing this half term, we will be looking at **Word Processing** and **Presentation Skills**. The children will learn how to use Google Docs on the Chrome Book to type up work and save into their class folder. The Year 2 children will learn how to use PowerPoint.

RHE Through JIGSAW

We will be following the topic "**Relationships**".
The children will be talking about the different relationships they have with family and friends. We will also be talking about how to be a good friend.

Music

We will be following the topics "**Round and Round**" and "**Friendship**".
These units focus on Bossa Nova music. The children will also be learning how to use instruments, compose music and then perform for others.

RE

In **Year 1** the children will be learning about some stories of Jesus. They will be acting them out to retell them.
In **Year 2** the children will be learning about the Jewish faith and the festival of Shabbat.
