<u>Science</u>

Our focus this half term is Animals including Humans.

The children will be learning how to sort and group different types of animals. They will also be learning about the life cycle of a frog.

<u>Geography</u>

This half term we will be learning about the seven continents and five oceans are in the world. We will be learning where they are on a map, what the weather is like there and the different animals that live there.

Art and design

The children will be learning about the artist Michelle Reader. She makes animals from recycled materials. We will be visiting her at her Gallery and then the children will be then making their own ocean animal made out of recycled objects.

<u>P.E.</u>

We will be continuing to focus on striking and fielding in **Games** so that the children can play Kwik Cricket with their classes. We will also be doing some

Gymnastic lessons, where the children will be using their skills on the large apparatus.

<u>English</u>

We shall be using the texts: -The Snail and the Whale and Tiddler. All children will have Handwriting, Grammar and Spelling lessons throughout the week. In shared reading, the teachers will be focusing on Fiction and Non-Fiction texts about ocean animals and pollution.

<u>Maths</u>

The children will be having Maths lessons every day focused on: -

Yr1- Fractions, Shape, Multiplication and Division

Yr2-Statistics, Position and Direction and Addition and Subtraction.

Computing

In computing this half term, the Year 1 children will be learning how to use the **Scratch Junior programme** to program different characters.

The Year 2 children will also be using **Scratch Junior** to create a quiz about Ocean animals.

RHE through JIGSAW

We will be following the topic **"Changing me".**

The children will be talking about how people's life changes as they get older.

They will be discussing their feelings around moving classes or schools.

<u>Music</u>

The children will be following the **Reflect, Rewind and Replay** unit of the **Charanga Music scheme.** They will be listening and appraising different music. Then they will be learning how to sing different songs and accompany them with instruments. Finally, they

We will be focusing on the topic of **"Story"**
